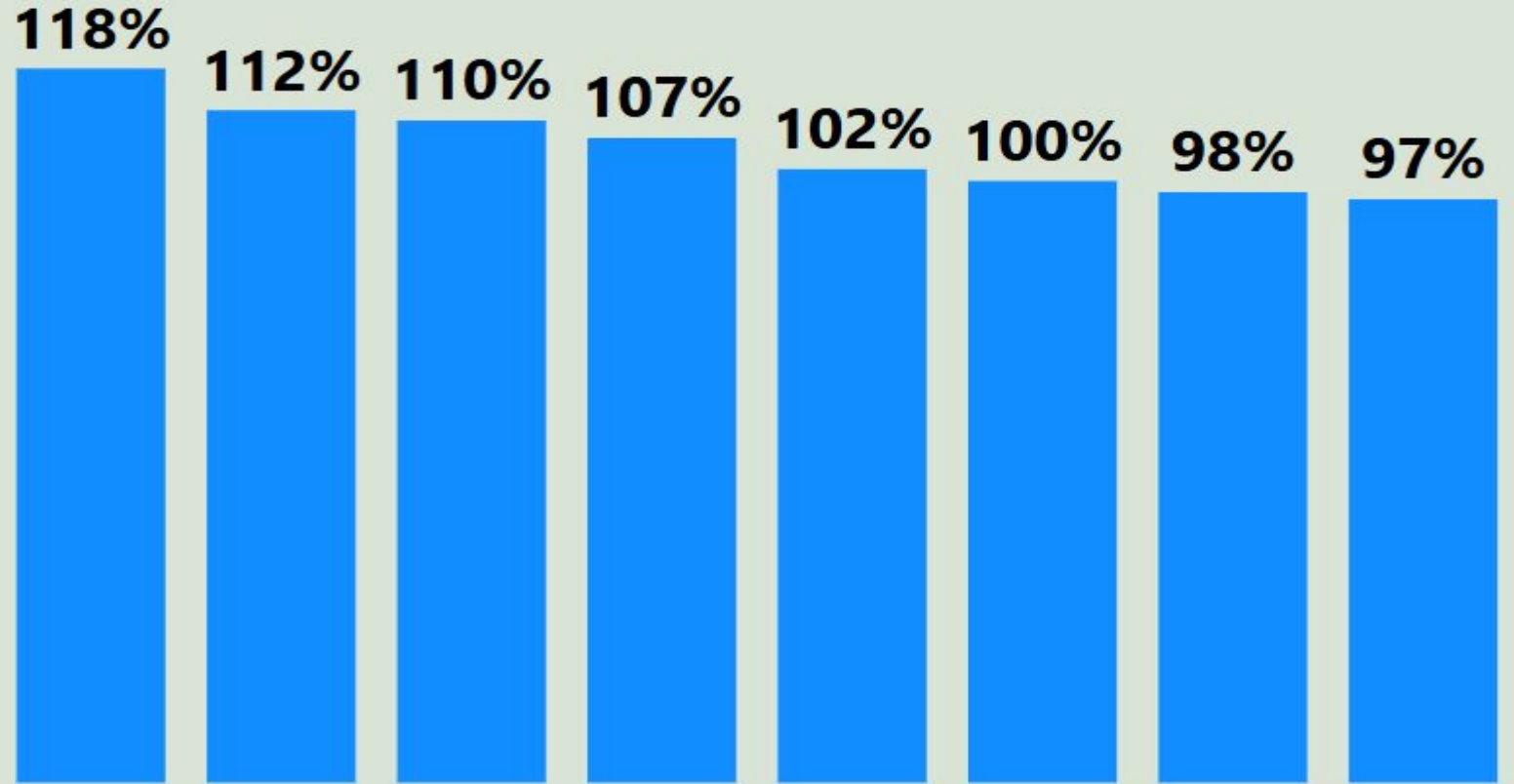

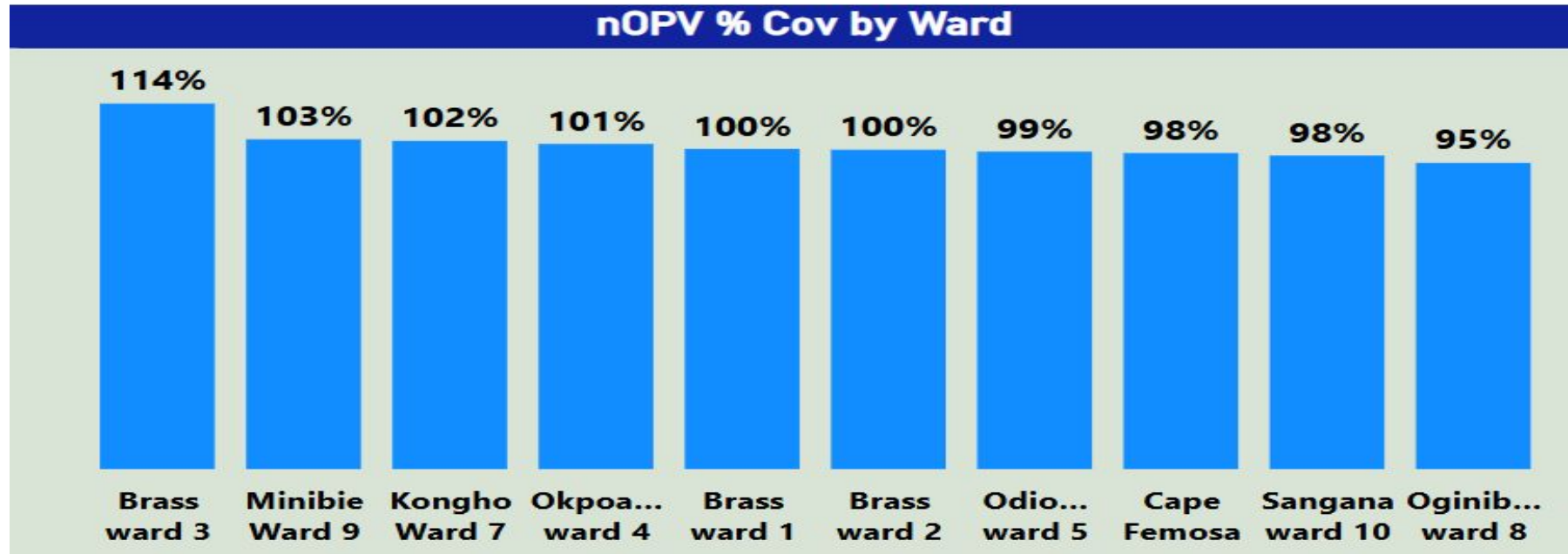

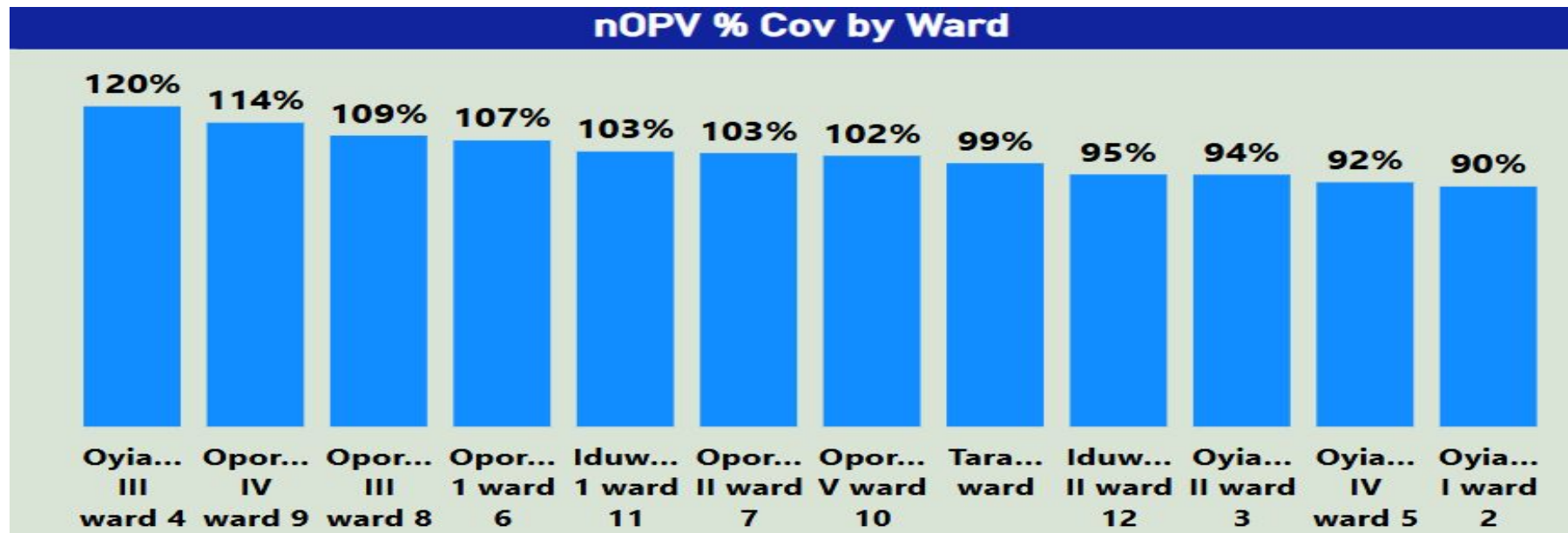

Coverages by Ward (Brass/Ekeremor)

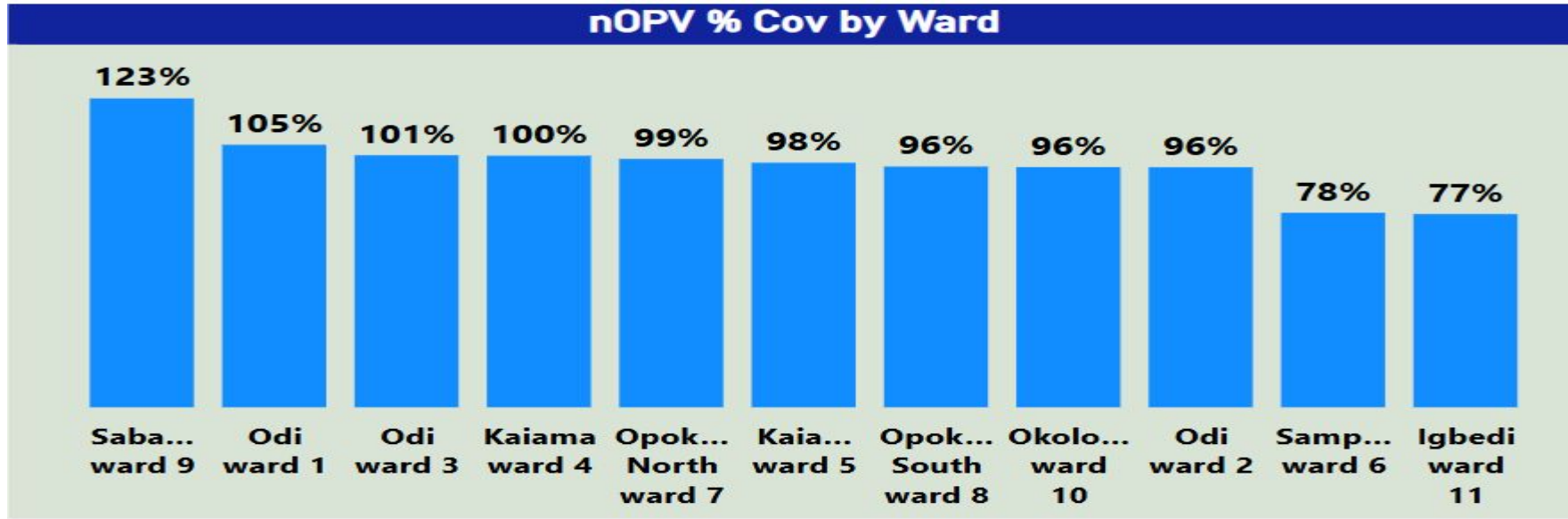


Brass: Brass 3 highest coverage of 114% while Oginibiri is the least with 95%

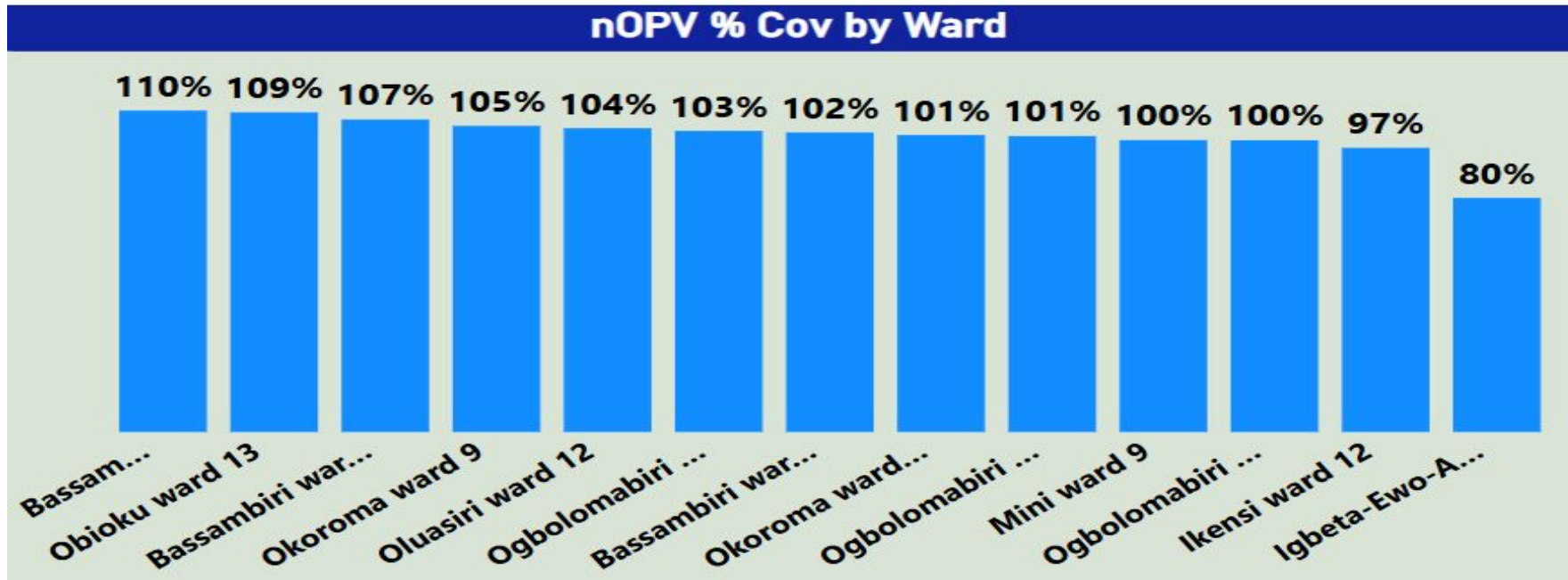


Ekeremor: Oyiakiri 3 highest coverage of 120% while Oyiakiri 1 is the least with 90%

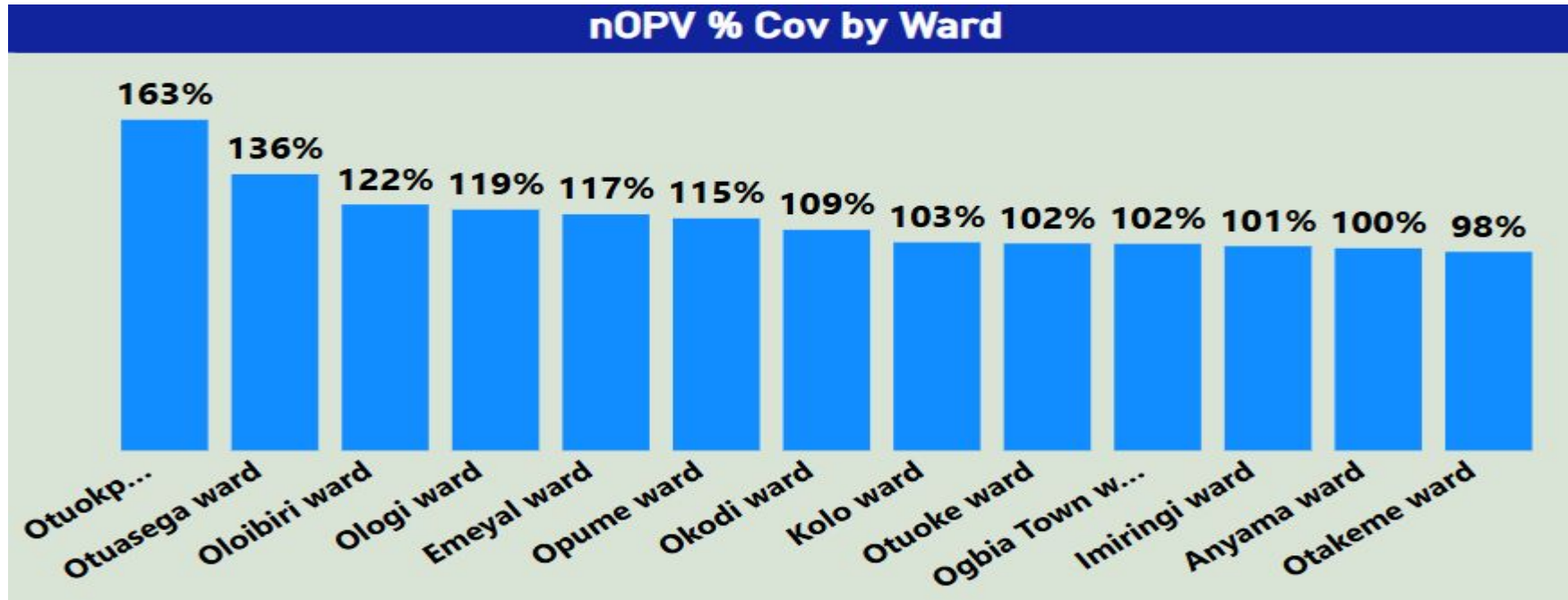

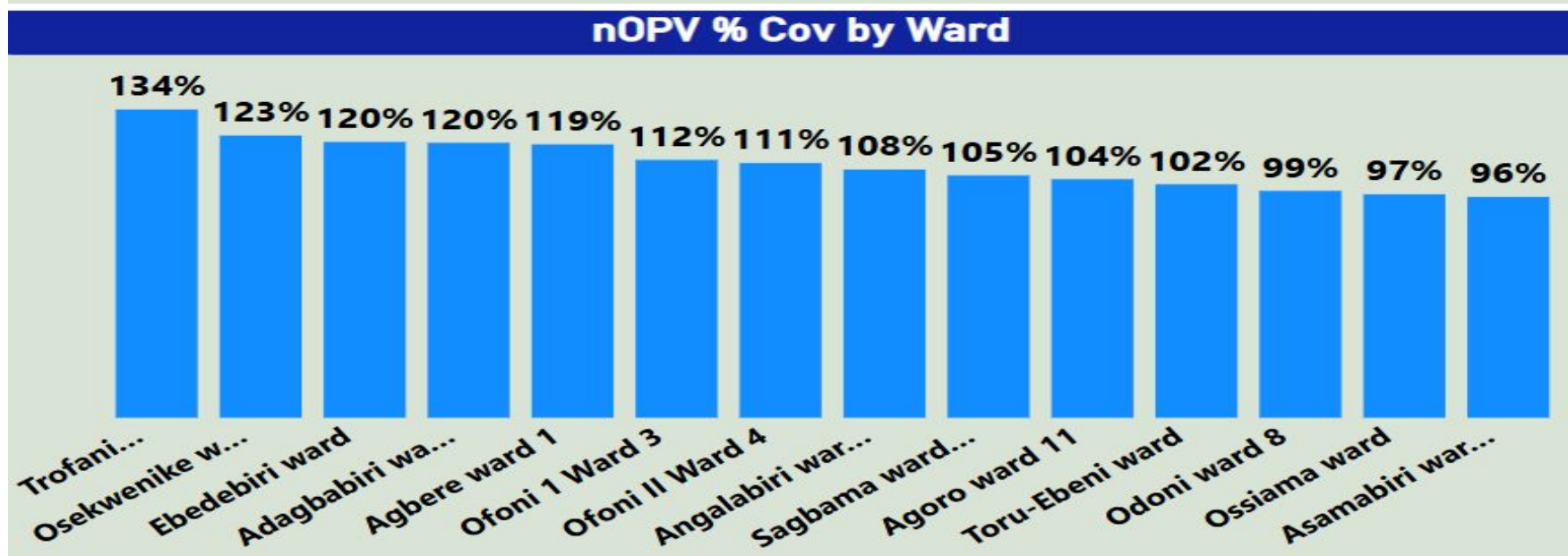

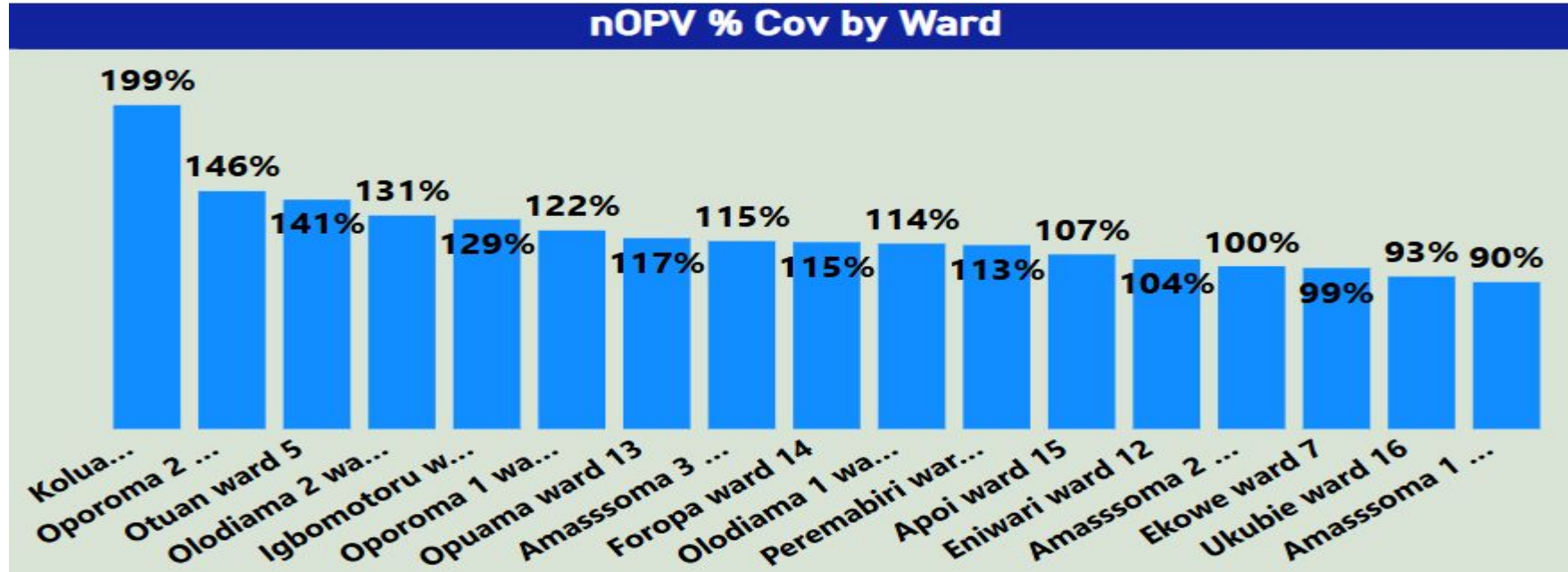

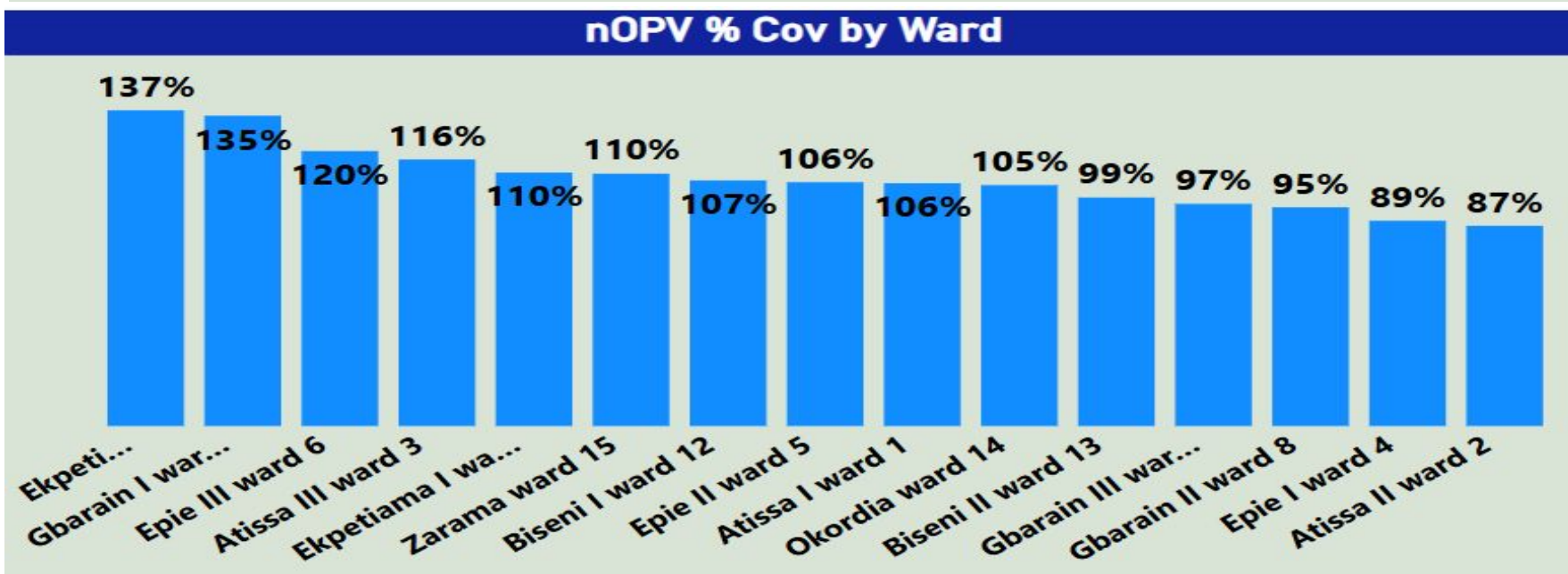

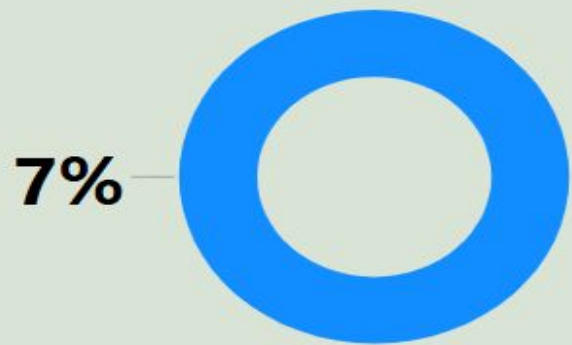

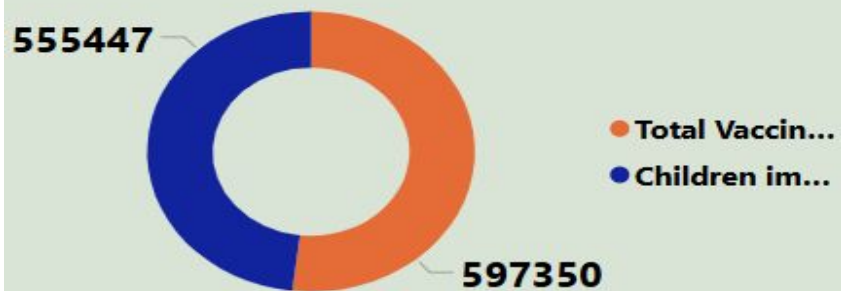

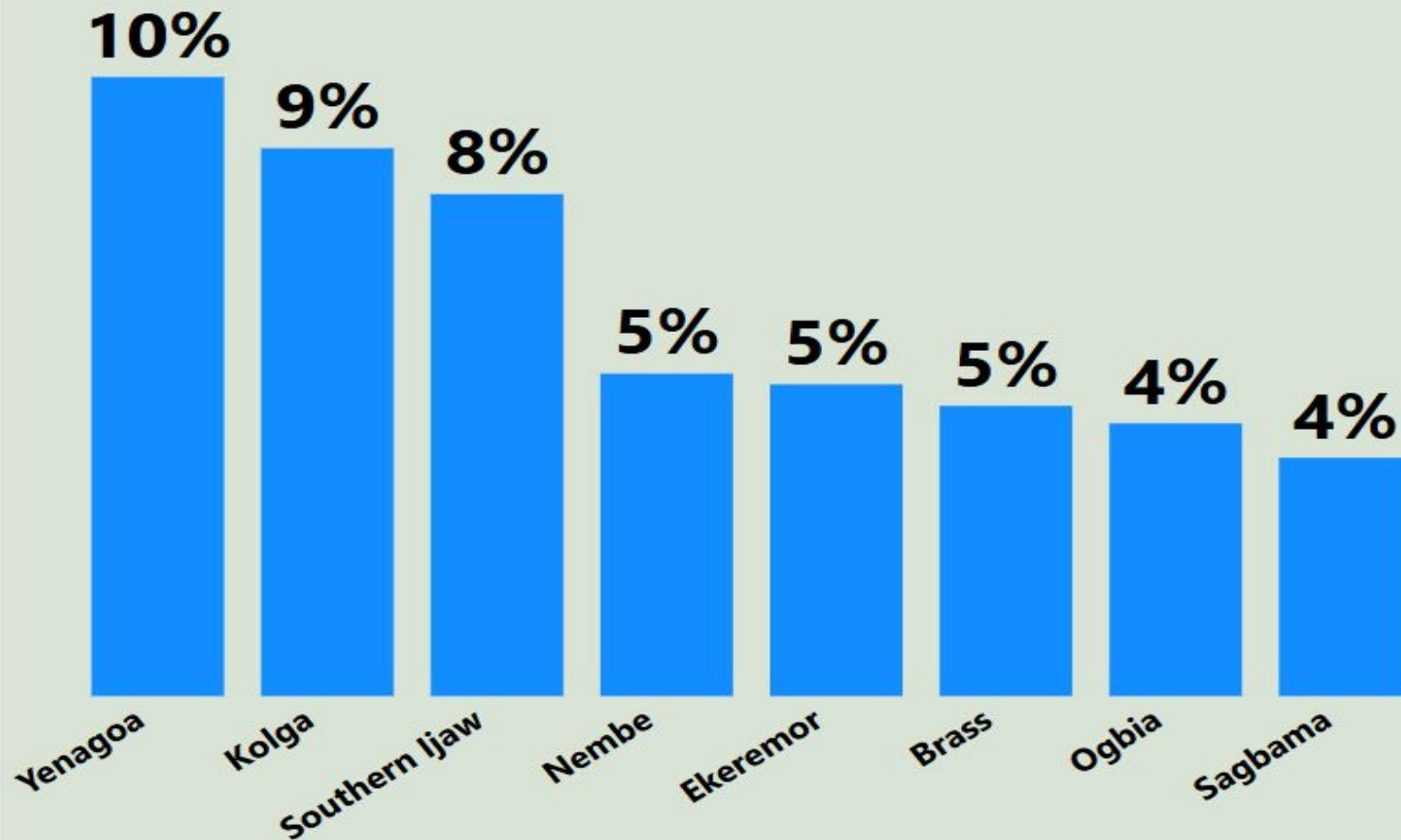

nOPV WR by LGA

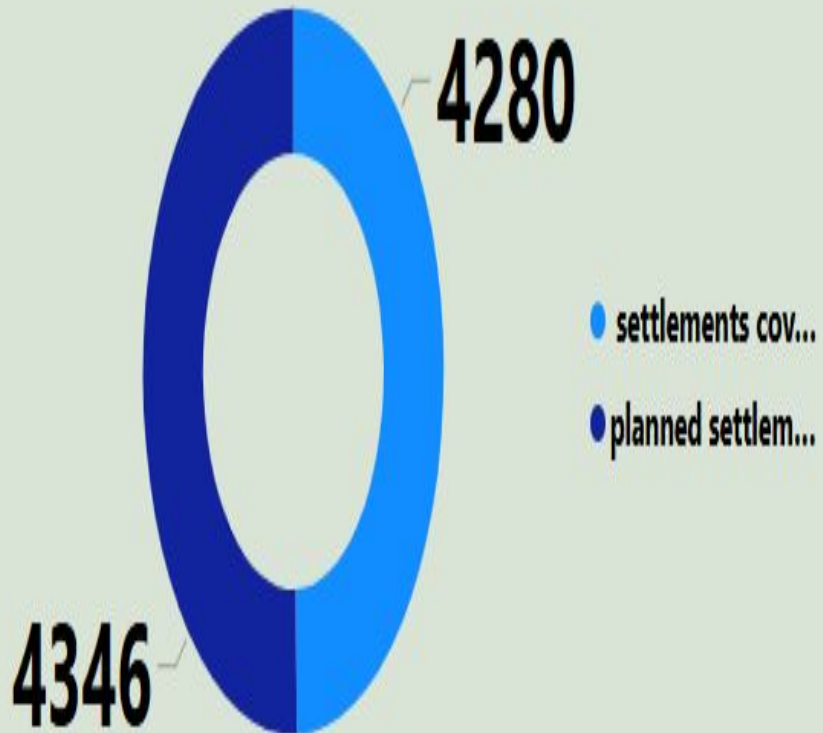

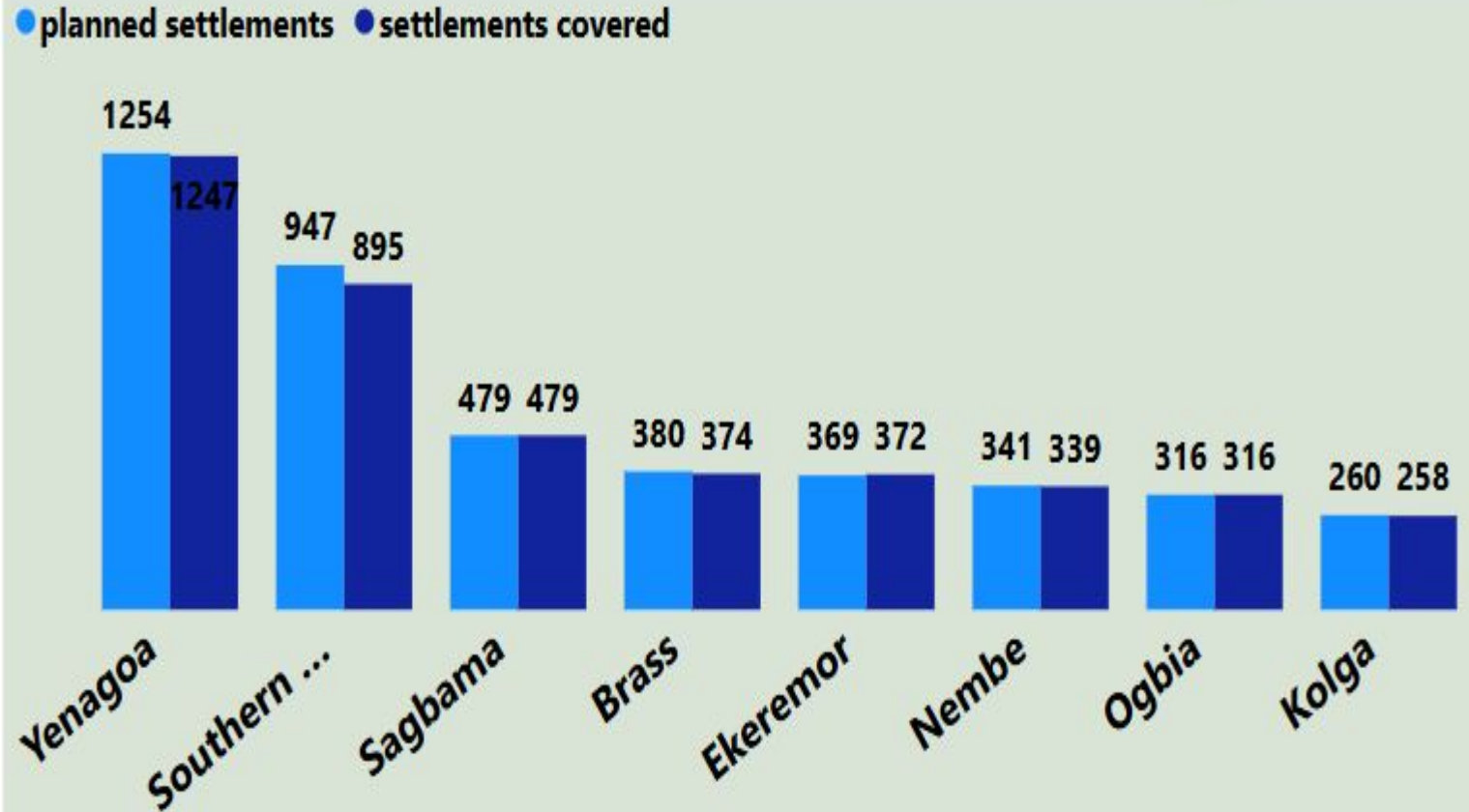

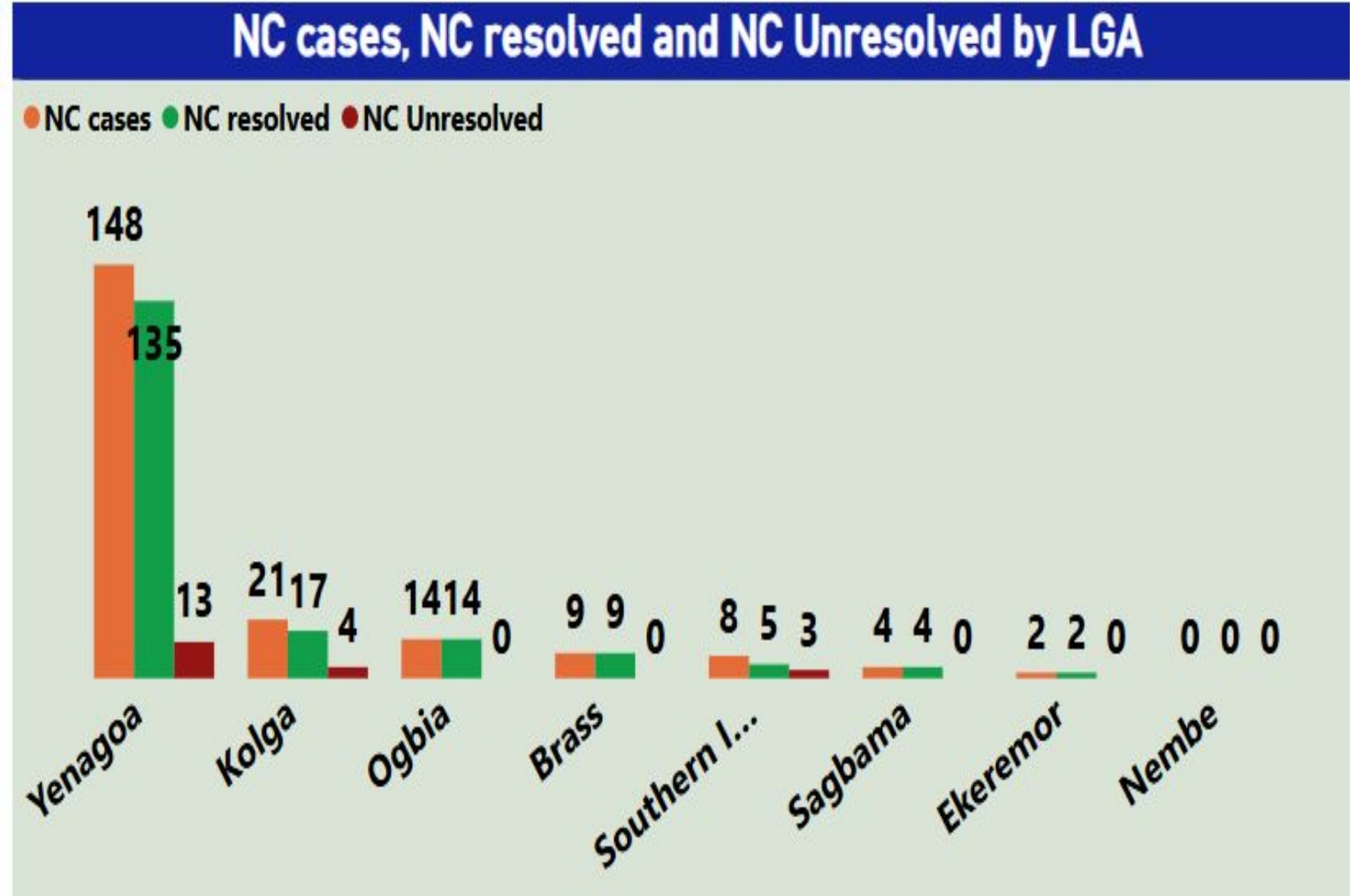
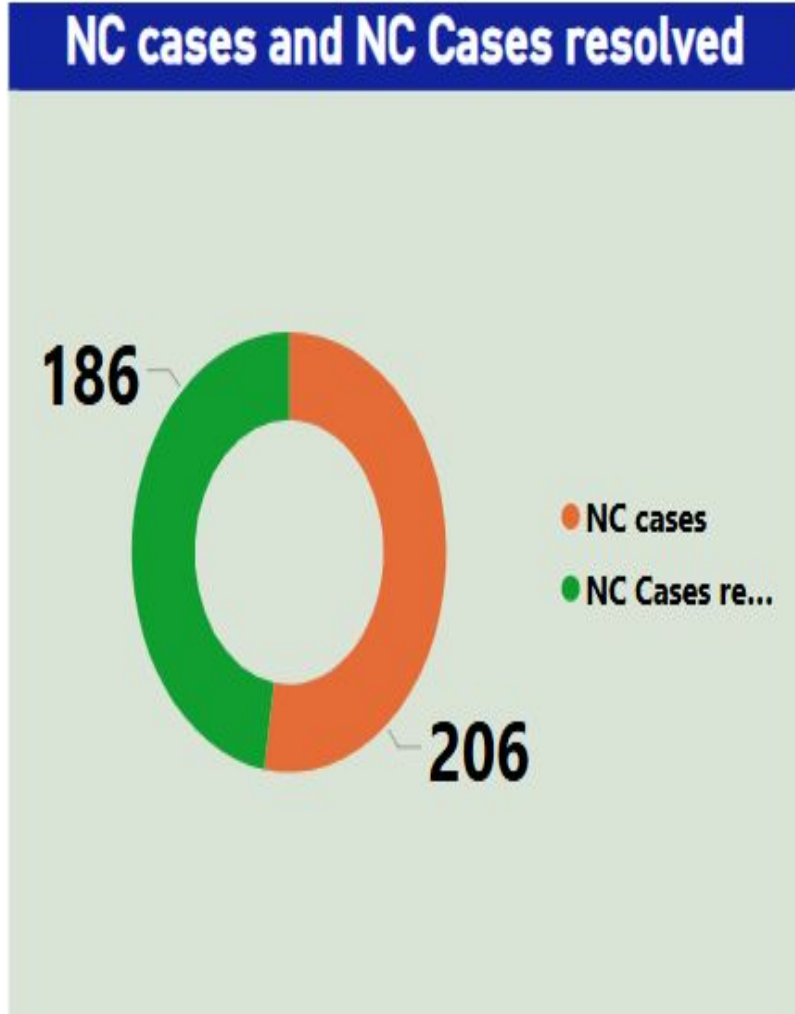

Non-Compliance by State / LGA

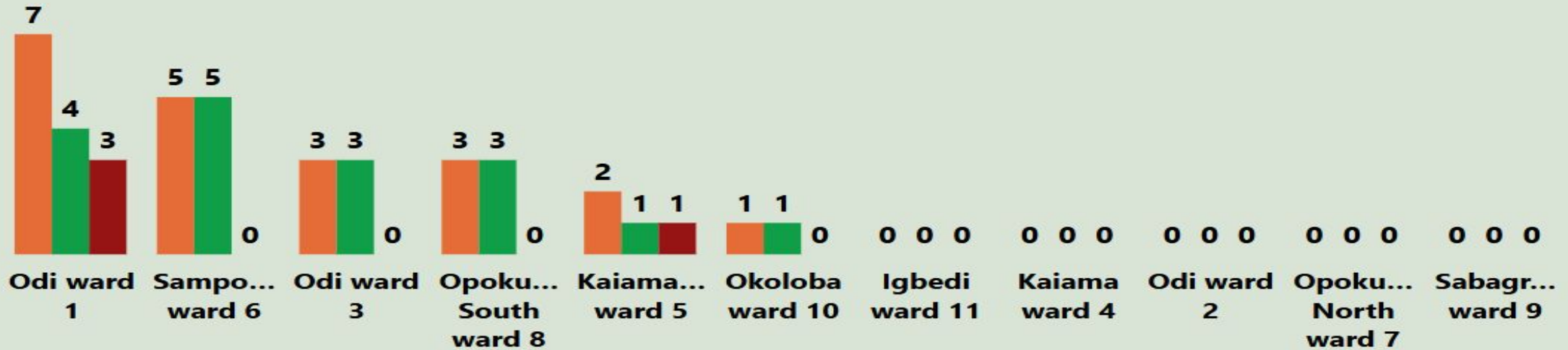

Non-Compliance by Kolga/Southern Ijaw

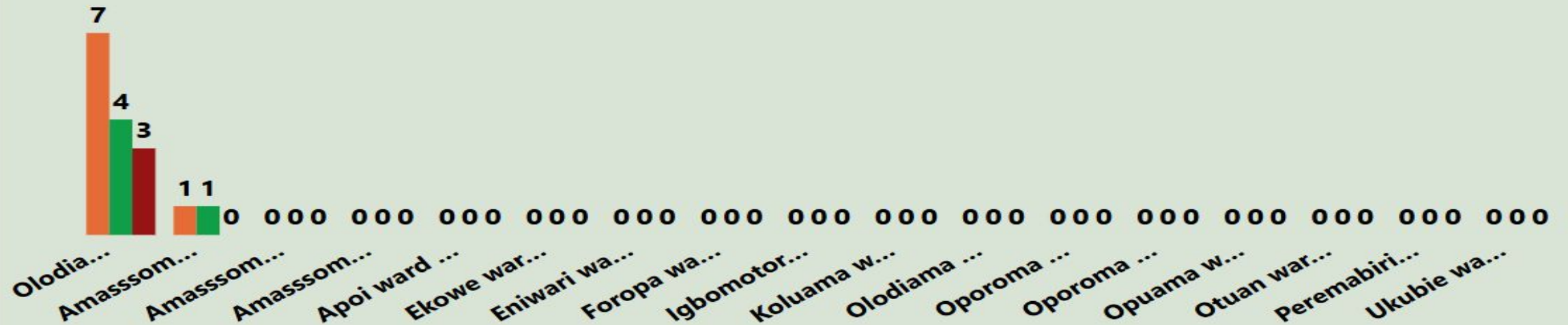

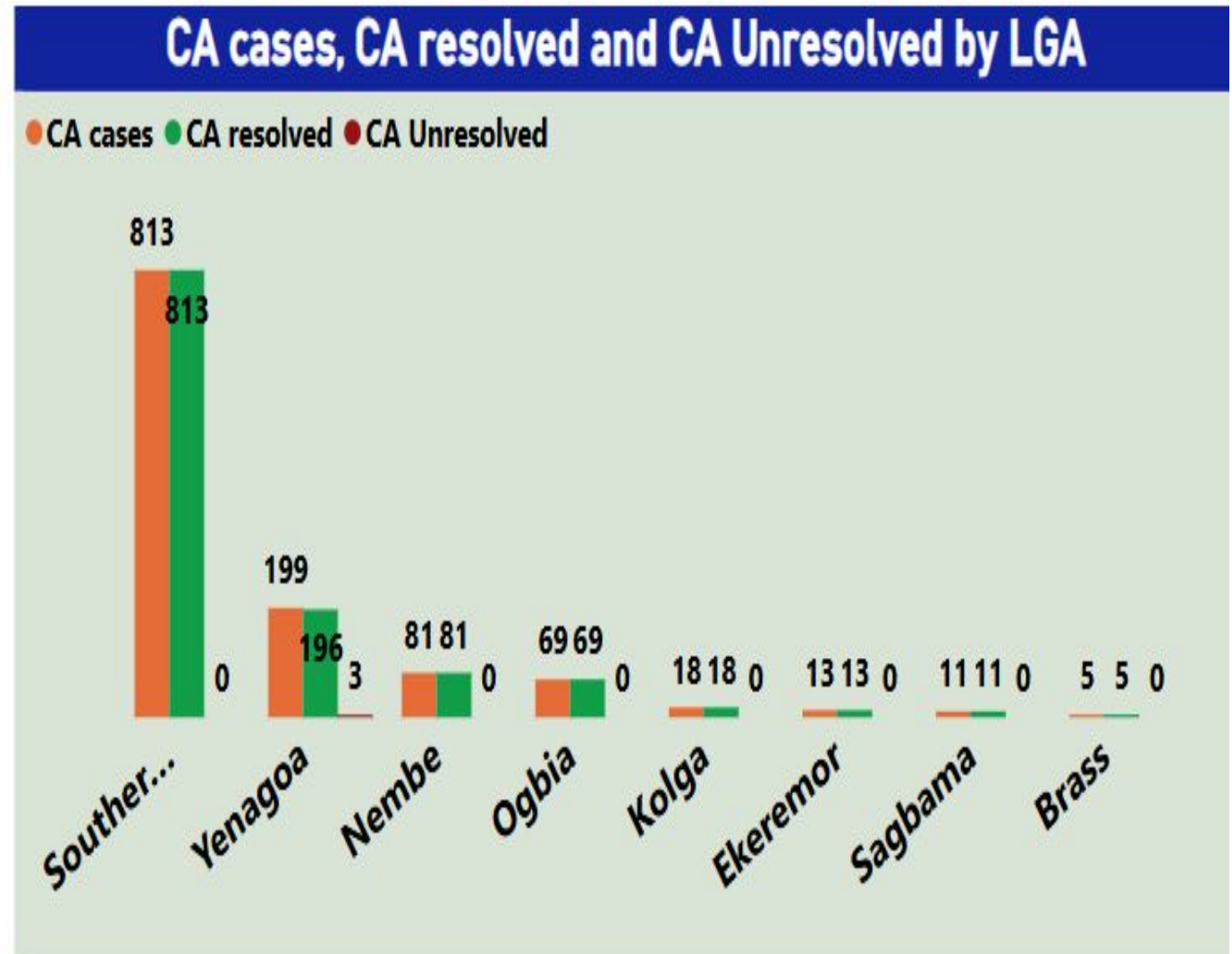

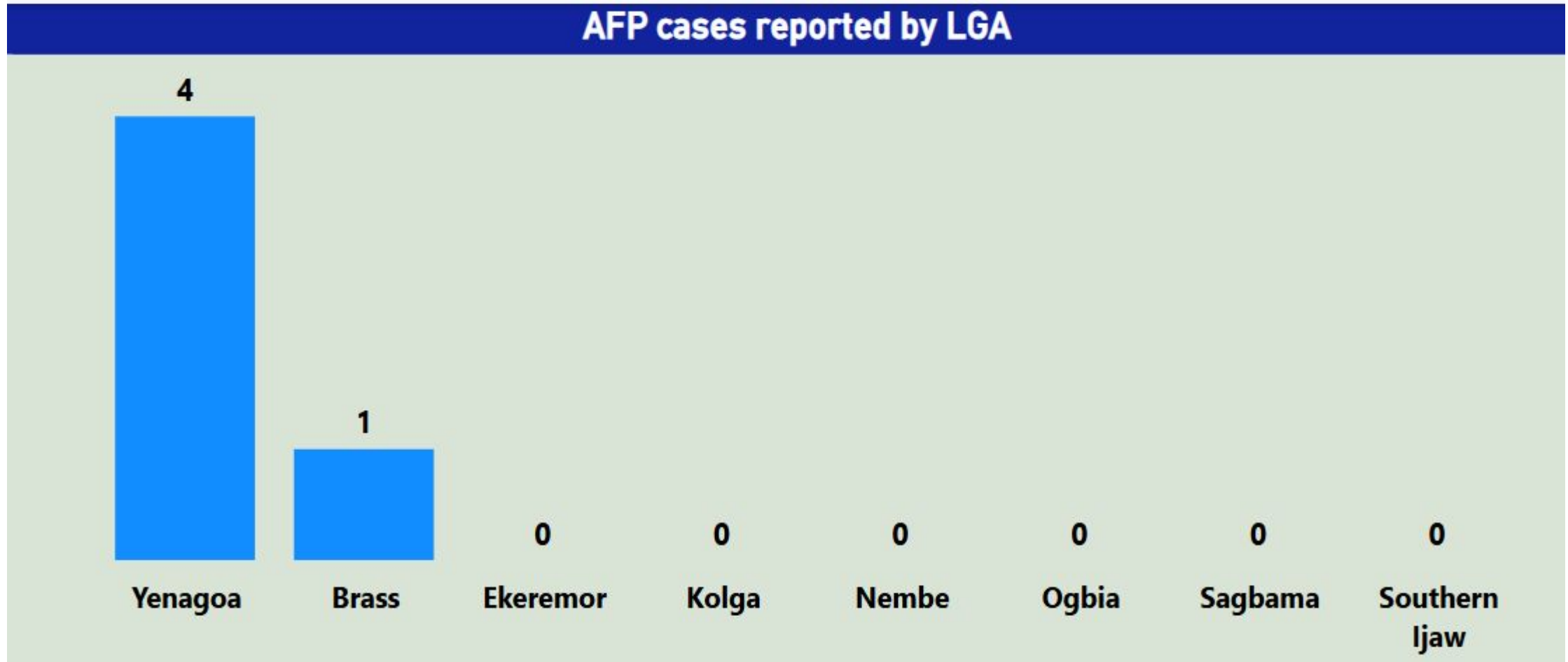
